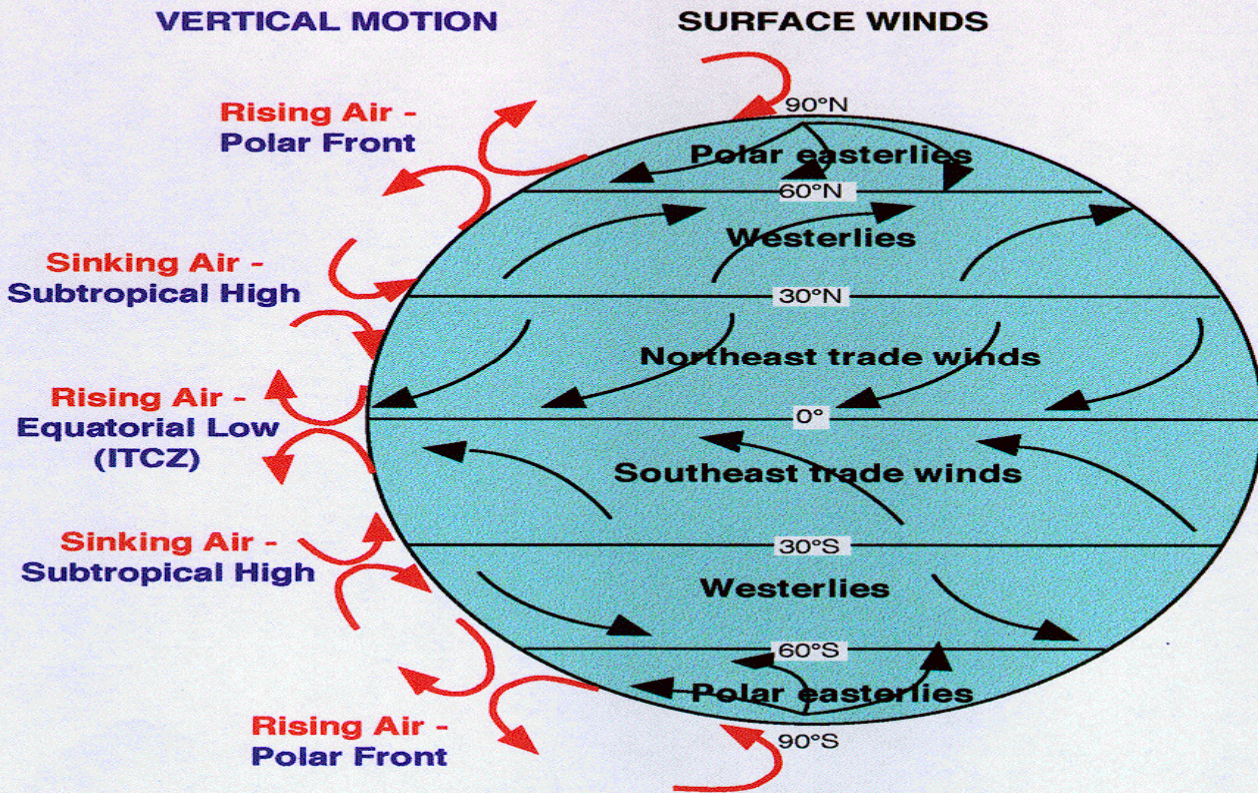


Generalized Sketch of Global Atmospheric Circulation
